Agenda

1. Sanitiser - donation from Drimnin Distillery - Annabel has kindly donated 40 x 100mls for vulnerable members of the community, shop and local key workers. AT to liaise with Dr Taylor to organise distribution. Amy will research gin distilleries who are making sanitiser that the committee can purchase for outside spaces e.g. for petrol pumps, gates on popular walks.
2. Community Support update -calls minimal. KM to promote telephone calls for those feeling isolated and who feel they would like a friendly chat on a daily basis or as often as they would like. New skip at Lochaline half full - group will monitor and review next week and if needed group will look at potential options. Would be helpful to know if more rubbish is anticipated.
3. Shop - working well and thanks to all at Lochaline stores.
4. Medical Practice. Importance of exercise discussed in maintaining individual good health and resilience. Gates at Achnaha discussed - AF will alter gates so there is no need to touch, at least, the metal parts. Group discussed putting sanitisers near gates of popular walks when more available. Community to be asked to save any old pump bottles eg soap, moisturiser for sanitiser which will be bulk purchased. Box will be left at petrol pump - ACTION KM. Bulk sanitizer to be ordered if possible- AR.
5. BT Broadband back up. Vodafone dongles more difficult to source - Lilia exploring this. Emergency dongle given to surgery. Openreach meeting 19th May 3-4.
6. AOB - gloves, bin bags etc - KM to offer to volunteers. Remainder to be kept in store for when needed.
