

WE ARE RECRUITING!



Morvern Community Trading Company (MCTC) are building a team to help us operate Lochaline Harbour, the Barr Hydro Scheme and all other MCDC owned community assets.

There are four positions available. While we are happy to consider separate applications for any of the four positions and options for job sharing, we would prefer to create full time jobs, if possible, and would favour one person as harbour master and another covering the other three posts.

The positions to be filled are:

THE HARBOUR MASTER (HM) who will be responsible to the MCTC board for all aspects of the successful running of Lochaline Harbour pontoons, moorings, and shore facilities. (Minimum contracted Hours: Summer Season 5 hours/day for 5 days/week, winter 5 hours pw maintenance only).

THE ASSISTANT HARBOUR MASTER (AHM) responsible to the HM for assisting the HM in fulfilling this role (Summer Season min 5 hours/day for 2 days/week).

THE BARR HYDRO CARETAKER (BHC) who will be supported for all technical issues by specialists from Glen Hydro and will be the local person, responsible to the MorVolts board, for operation of the scheme including maintenance, monitoring and first responder for faults. (Minimum average 1 day pw).

THE MCDC HANDYPERSON (HP) who will be an individual with practical skills who will be responsible for maintenance of all aspects of MCDC assets, including buildings. (Minimum average 1 day pw – possible extension to 2 days pw).

We envisage that employment terms will be under the full PAYE system with accompanying rights and responsibilities although, for some of the positions at least, we may consider the alternative of a self-employed contract.
